

WRTA Bustracker Signs

What it all Means...

1 Stop ID Number
Look for the unique Stop ID number at your bus stop. Use your stop ID to get bus arrival information on your phone.

2 Stop Name
Landmark or cross-road intersection nearest to the stop.

3 Bustracker Info Line
Call WRTA's Information Line at **508.296.TRAK(8725)** to have the next bus arrival times read to you over the phone. Use your dial pad to type in the Stop ID number. Or you can tell the voice recognition system your Stop ID Number.

4 Text Message
Send a text message to the WRTA to get your next bus arrival times.
Text **"WRTA [stop id]"** to **41411**
Make sure to leave a space between WRTA and your stop ID number.

5 Web
Use the WRTA's interactive website on your computer, tablet or smartphone to get your next bus arrival times.
