CAMBRIDGE ST. RESIDENT OR BUSINESS OWNER:

With the start of 2015 we thought you would like to know what the status is of our project, and what you can anticipate in the coming year.

Overview:

The City's Cambridge St. Sewer Rehabilitation Project will make repairs to the sanitary sewers. The purpose of this work is to extend the life of this critical sanitary sewer interceptor by improving the structural integrity of the pipe, restoring flow capacity, and reducing inflow and infiltration. Trenchless rehabilitation methods selected for this project consist of lining the existing 100+ year old sewer with a cured-in-place pipe. This project requires bypassing flows while personnel perform the work in the existing sewer pipes. The large twin 18" pipes that you have seen being buried in the roadway and across some sidewalks are the bypass system.

The City's Contractor, Green Mountain Pipeline Services, Inc. started construction in September 2014 and will continue into late Spring of 2015.

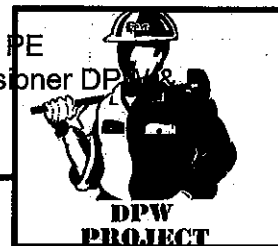
The anticipated schedule follows:

- Set up of the first section of Bypass piping is complete. An additional section will be set up later in the project.
- Traffic detour started in mid-November 2014 and will continue through mid-May 2015
- A pumping station has been installed in the center of Cambridge St. at Webster Sq.
- Green Mountain will provide notifications to affected properties 48-hours prior to the start of work at each specific location.
- Bypass piping removal will start in March 2015 and continue through May 2015
- Final paving will occur in July 2015
